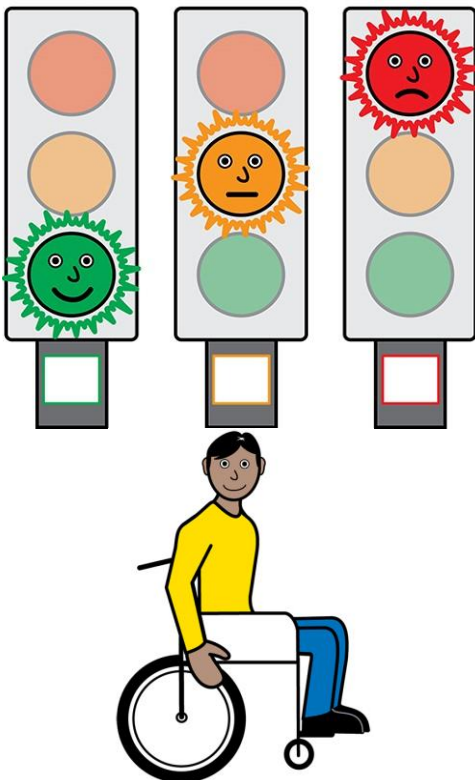


Variety Show

If these are problems for you please let us know so that we can tell the council.



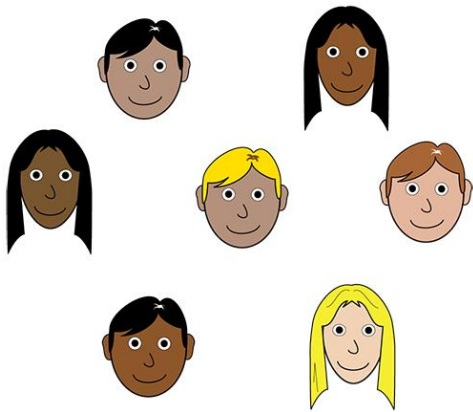


